



## BRIGHT-YELLOW LADYBIRD (*Illeis gabula*)



**A**ctive period of Adults: Spring and Summer

**H**abitat: Botanical, suburban, rural cultivated gardens

**S**tatus: common in NE Victoria

**D**istribution: also in New South Wales

**A**dditional notes: Ladybirds are beneficial for Rose gardens as they love devouring Aphids, these tiny little pests can be a real problem, as they suck the juices out of the rose stems, if you have Ladybirds its good to have them for the control use of Aphids.
